Colossians 1:13-20

Review

- Colossians 1:15-20 are written in the poetic rhythm of a song. What song has recently been going through your mind? Why do you think this particular song has stayed with you?
- Think of a good Christian friend. How does he or she reflect God's image? How does Jesus Christ reflect God more completely than your friend?
- What problem have you encountered in helping someone understand why Jesus is the only way to God?

Remind

- What titles and descriptions of Jesus Christ do you find in in this passage? List as many as possible.
Begin each with, "Jesus Christ is ... "
- What is Jesus' position in the church (v.18)?
- What did Jesus do on the cross at Calvary (v.19-20)?

Respond

- What difficulties do you have in relating to an invisible God? How has Jesus overcome those difficulties? (v.15)
- How did some recent choice that you made about your time or money reflect Christ's supreme place in your life?
- In what practical ways is Christ's headship evident in Goldstone Church?
- You could end by reading again / memorise Colossians 1:16:
"For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him."
