- Describe a time when you disregarded a Warning Sign or notice. What were the consequences of your actions?
- If your house was burning down, what <u>three</u> objects would you try and save? Why did you chose these?
- Name a gift that you will never forget. Why was it so memorable?

Read About

- What does the author ask us to do with the message that we have heard (v.1)?
- > Who spoke the binding message (v.2a)?
- > What was the consequence of disobedience (v.2b)?
- Who first declared the message of salvation (v.3)? Who had heard the message of salvation?
- What are the ways in which God testifies to the authenticity of this message of salvation (v.4)?

Think About

- This passage is often described as a "warning". Instead of looking at this in a negative sense, how would you rephrase or paraphrase these verses using positive vocabulary?
- Do you think this warning to be (more) attentive to God's message of salvation is relevant today? Why, or why not?
- In what areas of your life do you need to take more careful attention to what God is saying?

Hebrews 2:1-4

¹ We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ² For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, ³ how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴ God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.
