Small Group Questions

Hebrews 3:1-6

Talk About

- Who is the most important person you have ever met? (e.g. a celebrity, politician, etc.)? How did it feel to meet them?
- Describe yourself in just 3 words...
- There are over 200 names and titles for Jesus in the Bible. Which ones are your favourite? Why?

Read About

- How does the writer to the Hebrews describe the people to whom he is writing (v.1)?
- Which *two* people were “faithful in all God’s house” (v.2)?
- Compare the lives and activities of Jesus and Moses (v.2-3). Who has the greater honour (v.3)? Why?
- What picture/image does the writer use to explain that Jesus is greater than Moses (v.4)? What other image/s could have been used?
- How is Moses described (v.5)? Is this a valid description?
- Who are described as Jesus’ “house” (v.6)? What conditions are attached to this description?

Think About

- How have you seen Christians demonstrate to you how to remain faithful and true to Jesus Christ? How have you done so to others?
- How is Jesus your High Priest? What have you done to demonstrate who He is and what others can be too?
- How does Jesus get you through life? How could He do this better? What do you need to do?
- You could end by reading / memorising Hebrews 3:6.

Hebrews 3:1-6

¹ Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, the apostle and high priest whom we confess. ² He was faithful to the one who appointed him, just as Moses was faithful in all God's house. ³ Jesus has been found worthy of greater honour than Moses, just as the builder of a house has greater honour than the house itself. ⁴ For every house is built by someone, but God is the builder of everything. ⁵ Moses was faithful as a servant in all God's house, testifying to what would be said in the future. ⁶ But Christ is faithful as a son over God's house. And we are his house, if we hold on to our courage and the hope of which we boast.
